

12TFW - 2018 Tucson Reunion Update As of December 2017

The 2018 Tucson reunion is now just four months away. **It is never too early to make hotel reservations--** especially if you plan to participate in the Range trip so as to receive the \$109 Reunion Rate for shoulder dates. **Reunion dates rate is \$109/night (includes Breakfast Buffet for 2, a \$20 value!)** The Radisson also offers an airport shuttle for \$10/person. **So, stop procrastinating, make your hotel reservation today!**

Wednesday, 4 April 2018: Registration in the Hospitality Room from 1200-2100 hrs. Hospitality Room/Bar open with light snacks and *h'orderves*. Dinner on your own.

Thursday, 5 April: Morning visit to the Pima Air & Space Museum; lunch at the Davis-Monthan AFB Club; early-afternoon visit to the AMARG aircraft "Boneyard". Return to the Radisson by mid-afternoon. Hospitality Room/Bar open. Dinner on your own.

Friday, 6 April: Morning visit to either the A-10 equipped 355th Fighter Wing at Davis-Monthan AFB or the F-16 equipped 162nd Wing (Arizona Air National Guard) at Tucson Int'l Airport. Friday afternoon free. Hospitality Room/Bar open. Informal dinner at the hotel.

Saturday, 7 April: Morning Memorial Ceremony honoring fallen comrades, Association Business Meeting. Afternoon free. Hospitality Room/Bar open. Saturday evening Banquet at the Radisson will conclude the Reunion.

Three types of rooms for \$109/night during the 4-7 April 2018 Reunion dates. **Shoulder dates may be \$109/night or higher subject to availability.**

STE4 and STE5 are **Premium Suites** with a room divider between the bedroom and living room. A 1-Bedroom suite is similar to a spacious, undivided single hotel room with a living/work area. All rooms have new furniture and 100 of the hotel's 299 rooms have received complete make-overs during the last year.

CANCELLATION POLICY:

NLT 24 hours prior to 6:00 PM hotel time for the first night that you have reserved

Only Arizonans know what the local time really is; but after some research, I conclude that that AZ remains on Mountain Standard Time (MST) following the 11 March 2018 change over to Daylight Savings Time (DST) by the rest of the U.S. AZ Standard Time should be the same as Pacific Daylight Time (California) during the period of the reunion.
